

## IEG: THE 2ND EDITION OF ROMA AMUSEMENT SHOW CLOSED FUTURE PERSPECTIVES AND SCENARIOS OF THE GAME WITHOUT CASH WINNINGS

## The second edition of RAS confirmed last year's success. During the conferences, proposals for the world of pure entertainment

*Roma, October 11th 2019* - Play for fun. This was the leitmotiv that concluded the second edition of the Rome Amusement Show at the Fiera di Roma, the event dedicated to the world of gambling without cash winnings, capable of giving voice to the entire sector, underlining its identity and facing the future scenarios. The event, which was held simultaneously with Enada Roma, is the result of an agreement between Italian Exhibition Group, the FEE Consortium and the Sapar association, which will also see the organization of the 3<sup>rd</sup> edition of Rimini Amusement Show, simultaneously with the next edition of Enada Primavera, scheduled from March 11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> 2020 at the Fiera di Rimini.

On October 8<sup>th</sup> the Hon. Ettore Rosato, Vice-President of the House of Representatives and Senator Luigi Vitali took part in the ribbon-cutting ceremony. Present as well were Domenico Distante, President of SAPAR, Paolo Dalla Pria, President of SAPAR Service and Patrizia Cecchi, Exhibitions Italy Director Italian Exhibition Group.

In the afternoon the conference "What future for amusement? Among bans and confusion, thousands of companies at risk", organized by Sapar, Confesercenti Amusement Federation, FEE Consortium and New Asgi. The need for constructive confrontation with the government and unique national rules was discussed at the meeting.

Unanimous the warning of the operators, who invoked as only way to overcome the investment block caused by the uncertainty that is gripping the sector, the urgency of a clear regulation, which draws an unequivocal border line between paragraph 6 and paragraph 7 reaffirmed the need to give life back to a unified sector for the roundtable as soon as possible, for the creation of a disciplinary and to work together, with the certainty that a unified front is what gives more strength to the entire sector.

As explained by **Mauro Zaccaria**, Chairman of the FEE Consortium, once there was no cash-winning game and that was the start - gaming as pure entertainment. A vision of the sector that covers all age groups, from children to young people to adults and families.

And at the exhibition, alongside the debates, perspectives and hypotheses, there were also many operators, families, who tried the games, having fun. In the spirit of the event.

At the same time, the **Rome Pinball Tournament** competitions were held, which saw the Roman Gabriele Tedeschi win the 10<sup>th</sup> edition. The sports pinball tournament is valid for the international ranking and was also an opportunity to present the Stern "Jurassic Park" pinball machine.

The appointment with entertainment for all ages returns to **Rimini Amusement Show**, from March 11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> at the Rimini Expo Centre, simultaneously with Enada Primavera.
